Thank you for your interest in becoming a LinguistiKids Ambassador!


Our mission is simple: create fun language resources to support language learning at school or at home.

The role of a Language Ambassador

As an Ambassador, you would occasionally review selected materials and provide simple feedback—mainly proofreading, clarity suggestions, and spotting any errors or improvements. Your feedback helps us finalise the resources before they're published for families and teachers.

Your main tasks may include:

→ Reviewing

- Reviewing bilingual worksheets or kits before launch
- Checking vocabulary accuracy, grammar, cultural relevance

→ Suggestions

- Providing suggestions to improve clarity, usability, or inclusivity
- Offering ideas for new themes or topics

At the beginning of each year, we share a list of the topics and themes we plan to create resources for. You can then choose the topics that interest you most, so the materials you help review feel meaningful, relevant, and directly useful for your teaching.

We also want to respect your time. For this reason, we won't reach out more than twice per trimester with materials to review or quick feedback forms. Your involvement is designed to be flexible and manageable.



Benefits of being an Ambassador

What we ask from you:

We keep expectations light and manageable.

Ambassadors agree to:

- ➔ Provide feedback on materials with 7 to 10 days of receiving them,
- ➔ Keep all unreleased materials confidential,
- ➔ Give feedback honestly, respectfully, and constructively,
- ➔ Notify us if you need to pause or step away - no stress at all!
- ➔ You agree not to share or distribute any materials for free,
- ➔ All materials remain the property of LinguistiKids dependant on your given input in proofreading these.



How the review process works:

I send you a Canva link to the file which needs reviewing,




02

You review the vocabulary, translations, clarity and spelling.



03

You make comments directly in Canva on the corresponding page.



04

I apply improvements and may sometimes reach out with follow-up questions.



05

You receive a FREE copy of the final work + early access before public release.

LinguistiKids Ambassador Agreement (1/2)

This agreement is between LinguistiKids (“we/us”) and the Ambassador (“you”).

1. Role & Purpose

You volunteer to act as a LinguistiKids Language Ambassador, providing review and feedback on selected educational resources. At the end of the year, in preparation for the following year, we provide a list of the themes and topics we plan to develop resources for. You can then choose the topics that interest you most, so your participation is relevant, practical, and aligned with the needs of your students.

We also want to respect your time. For this reason, we won’t reach out more than twice per trimester with materials to review or quick feedback forms. Your involvement is designed to be flexible and manageable.

2. Activities

Your tasks may include:

- Occasionally review bilingual educational resources,
- Providing linguistic and usability feedback.

3. Compensation

This is a voluntary role. You are entitled to:

- The resource/s you reviewed completely free,
- 30% off all other LinguistiKids resources at any time,
- Early access to new resources before public release,
- Rewards whenever someone purchases using your code.

4. Confidentiality

You agree not to share or distribute any LinguistiKids materials—draft or final—for free, under any circumstances. All materials are strictly provided for review and personal use only.

5. Intellectual Property

All materials remain the exclusive property of LinguistiKids, whether or not you contributed feedback or proofreading. Providing suggestions does not grant ownership or distribution rights.

6. Conduct

You agree to provide feedback respectfully and in good faith.
